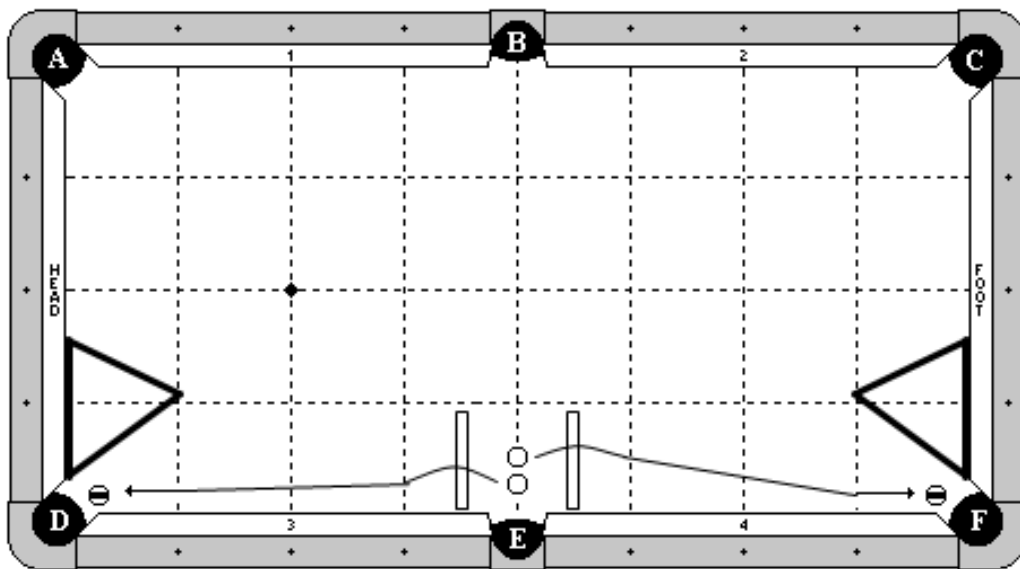


Jamey Gray – 1



Category: 1-Handed Jump

Difficulty: 10

Cue Ball: 2 cue balls are in hand along the B-E line

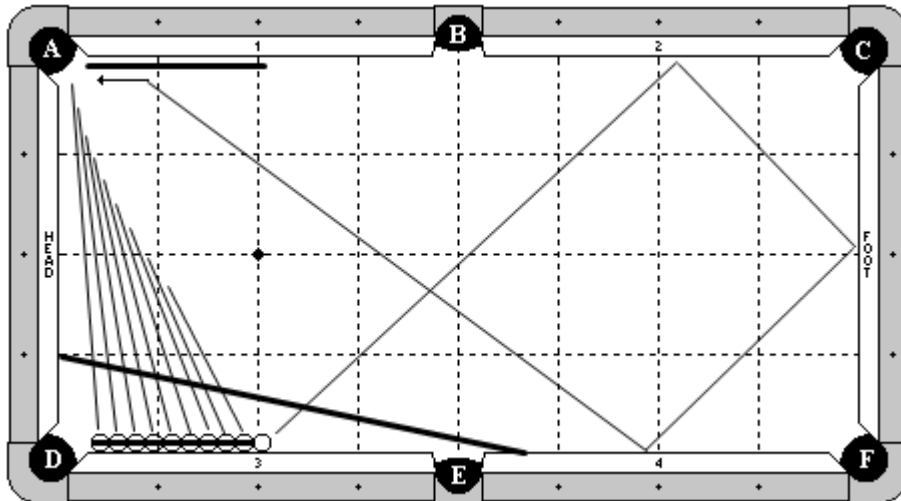
Object Ball: Object balls are hanging at pocket D and Pocket F

Props: 2 Racks are positioned as diagramed, 2 shafts or other barrier of $\frac{1}{2}$ inch height are positioned as diagramed 2 balls width from the cue balls

Objective: With 2 jump cues, (one handed left and one handed right) simultaneously jump the cue balls over the barriers in opposite directions to pocket balls in D and F.

Category – Jump/Speed

Difficulty: 10

Cue Ball: Frozen to rail and object balls

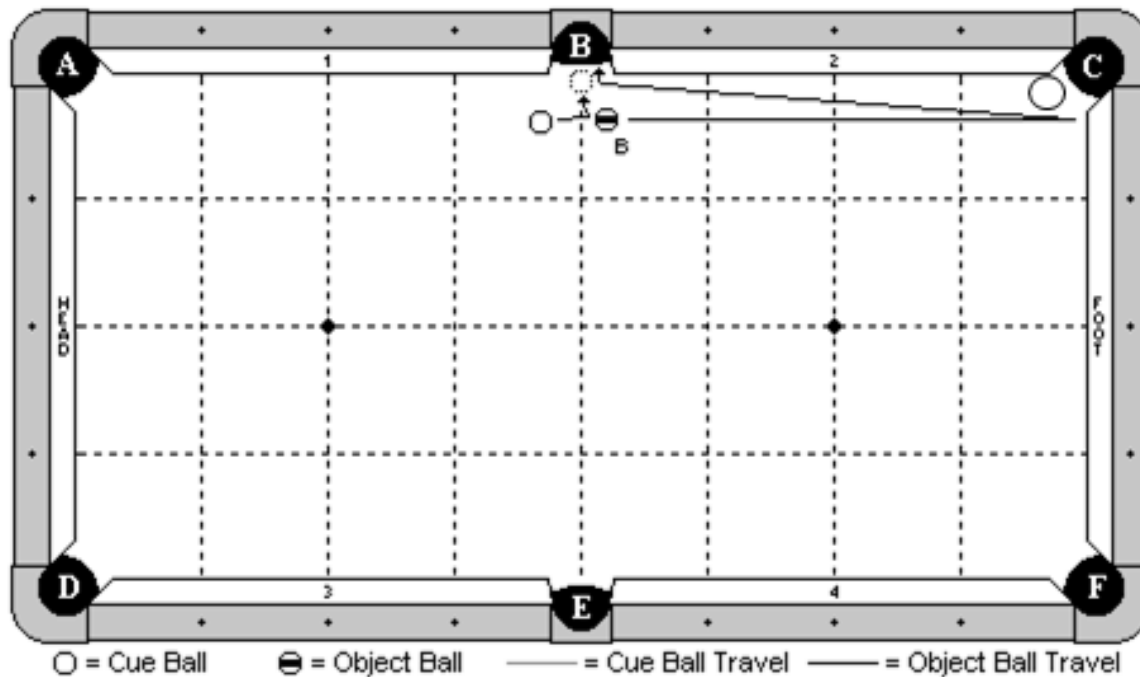
Object Ball: 9 object balls are frozen in line against rail as diagrammed. The left edge of first ball is even with pocket point.

Props: A cue is on the table with the tip end frozen to short rail at first diamond and butt frozen to cushion 4 as diagrammed. A cue butt is frozen against rail 1.

Objective: Jump the cue ball over cue and travel around table 3 rails into pocket A with possible aid of butt along rail 1. Then, starting from the left, jump each object ball over cue into pocket A before the cue ball goes in.

Category: Miscellaneous

Difficulty: 10

Cue Ball: In hand

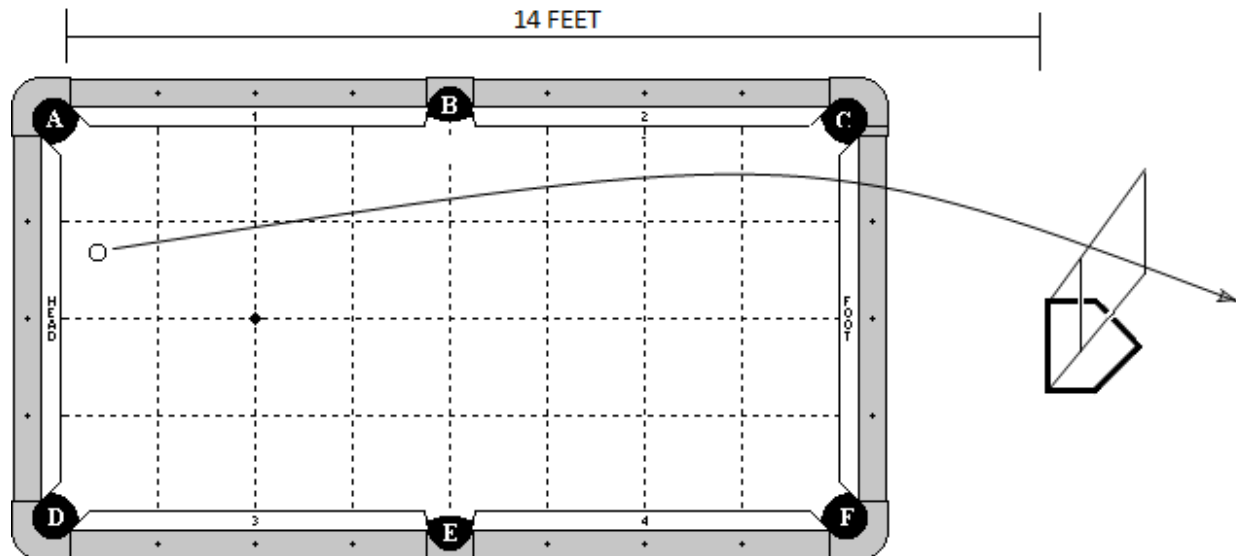
Object Ball: In Hand

Props: A bottle is in hand blocking pocket C

Objective: Shoot the cue ball into object ball causing it to bank off foot cushion, optionally contacting rail 2, then carom off cue ball and go into pocket B

Special Notes: None

Jamey Gray – 4



Category: Jump

Difficulty: 10

Cue Ball: in Hand within half diamond of head cushion

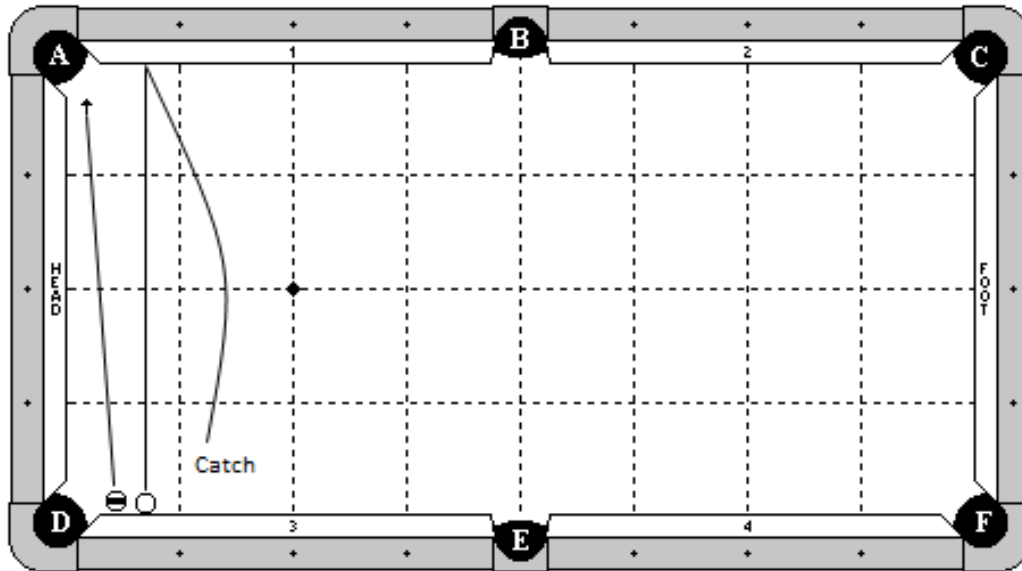
Object Ball: None

Props: A prop is used to simulate a strike zone in baseball. The plywood base is in the shape of home plate. The “strike zone” is made out of PVC tubing. The front edge of the strike zone is 14 feet from head cushion (see special notes). The bottom edge of “strike zone” is 19” from floor, top is 50” from floor, and it is 13” wide.

Objective: Jump Cue ball through strike zone

Special Notes: Depending on position of table, the head cushion may be substituted by cushion 1 and shot across the table instead of lengthwise. It's okay for the ball to touch the tubing as long as it goes through the strike zone. A sheet may be draped over the back of the strike zone to prevent the ball from traveling beyond. Otherwise, cushions can be used behind the prop to contain the cue ball.

Difficulty: 10

Cue Ball: in hand frozen to cushion 3

Object Ball: in hand frozen to cushion 3

Props: None

Objective: Shoot cue to jump off cushion 1, then shoot object ball into Pocket A, then catch cue ball.
